ALUMNI DONATIONS

One of the functions of the Horton High School Alumni Association is to support the Horton USD #430 school System in various ways. This year the Board wanted to give you an idea of what the past few years has looked like. The HHSAA has given approximately \$38,030.00 to the school district as well as students individually starting with \$19,750.00 in Scholarships to graduating seniors. Two trophy cases were constructed using Memorial donations from the families of Harold “Hinky” Richling, 1948 and Jere Pederson, 1959 along with \$3,125.00 from the Alumni Association; the trophy cases are located in the commons area at Horton High School. Additional shelving for trophies was added in the commons area in 2011 from donations received from the Class of 1958 & 1962. Donations of \$3,827.00 went to the Athletic Department for various things this also includes items for the Elementary and Middle Schools. Approximately \$2,482.00 was donated to the USD #430 Foundation. The balance went to the HHS Dance

Team and Cheerleaders for serving the banquet and helping with Alumni activities throughout the year, to Post Prom, the purchase of the new Electronic Events Board in front of the High School and a new display stand and frames for the class composite pictures.

The tenth annual Horton High School Alumni Games, this year being basketball, held in March 2018 was a great success!

The Board would like to thank Alumnus who have been so faithful in supporting the HHSAA over the years without your support none of this would be possible.
