

BROWN COUNTY VETERAN'S HONOR GUARD SCHOLARSHIP
(ONE YEAR ONLY)

This scholarship, for a graduating High School Senior, is sponsored by the Brown County Veteran's Honor Guard. Scholarship applications will be considered for the upcoming graduating class. The amount of the Scholarship will be \$500.00 and is to be awarded for only one year.

In selecting the scholarship recipient, the Brown County Veteran's Honor Guard will give substantial weight to past military service of the applicant's family. It is not the only factor to be considered but it should be understood it is a primary factor. Because of this an applicant should spend adequate time in determining or researching the military service of family members. Then you should make sure this information is correctly listed on the scholarship application.

The \$500 scholarship will be paid out once adequate evidence of application and admission into a college, university, community college or vocational/technical school has been provided by the scholarship recipient. Adequate evidence consists of a letter from the institution's registrar or office of student affairs establishing that the applicant is properly enrolled.

The scholarship recipient will be selected by the Honor Guard within ten (10) days of receiving completed applications from the Guidance Counselor's Office no later than April 7 of each calendar year for which the scholarship is offered. If no applications are received by April 7, no scholarship will be awarded for that calendar year. The Brown County Veteran's Honor Guard reserves the right to not award a scholarship, if the applicants do not meet the standard established herein.
